- 9. Pop music 1987: $\forall t \ge 0 \neg (G(\text{give you up}, t) \lor G(\text{let you down}, t) \lor G(\text{run around}, t) \lor G(\text{desert you}, t))$, where G(u, t) = ``I am going to do u at time t.''
- 10. Country music 1990: $\exists x \exists y (F(x) \land F(y) \land L(x) \land L(y) \land x \neq y)$, where F(x) = "I am friends with x" and L(x) = "x is in low places."
- 11. Pop music 1990: $\exists t > 0 \exists x (T(x,t) \land S(x,t))$, where T(x,t) = "At time t, x makes you turn around" and S(x,t) = "At time t, x makes you say goodbye."
- 12. Folk rock music 1965: $\forall u \exists t S(u, t)$, where S(u, t) = "t is the season for u."
- 13. Pop music 2011: $\neg S(you) \land \forall x ((x \neq you \land R(x)) \Rightarrow S(x))$, where S(x) = "x can see it" and R(x) = "x is in the room."

- 14. Country music 2010: $(T = 1:15) \land \neg (\exists y \neq I(W(I, y, T)) \land N(I, you, T)$, where T is the current time, W(x, y, t) = ``x is with y at time t," and N(x, y, t) = ``x needs y at time t."
- 15. Country music 2015: $\exists t_1 < 0 \big(K(\mathbf{I}, t_1) \land \forall t < t_1 \forall x \neg K(x, t) \big) \land \exists t_2 > 0 \big(K(\mathsf{she}, t_2) \land \forall t > t_2 \forall x \neg K(x, t) \big)$, where K(x, t) = "He kisses x at time t."
- 16. New wave music 1983: $\forall x (F(you, x) \Rightarrow \neg D(x)) \land \forall x (\neg D(x) \Rightarrow \neg F(I, x))$, where F(x, y) = ``x and y are friends'' and D(x) = ``x dances.''
- 17. Folk rock music 1972: $p \land q \land \exists x_1 \exists x_2 \exists x_3 \exists x_4 \exists x_5 \exists x_6 \exists x_7 (\forall i \in J(M(x_i) \land W(x_i)))$

$$\land \forall i \in J (i \leq 4 \Rightarrow O(x_i)) \land S(x_5) \land S(x_6) \land F(x_7) \land \forall i \in J \forall j \in J (i \neq j \Rightarrow x_i \neq x_j)),$$
 where $p =$ "I am running down the road," $q =$ "I am trying to loosen my load," $M(x) =$ " x is on my mind," $W(x) =$ " x is a woman," $O(x) =$ " x wants to own me," $S(x) =$ " x wants to stone me," and $F(x) =$ " x says that x is a friend of mine." Also, y is the index set $\{1,2,3,4,5,6,7\}.$
